

As Tower Hill carries out its mission, which includes a dedication to helping students with the growth of their characters, we consider SEL formative skills-based instruction that is critical. In each division, students currently participate in SEL offerings, such as Health and Wellness classes, mindfulness work and peer leadership activities. The faculty who offer this program are eager to work collaboratively as a group and under Dr. Cuddy's leadership to refine and expand the scope and sequence of these critical offerings schoolwide. 


